DESCRIPTION OF SCHOOL

Morley Senior High School is a modern, multi-level structure located close to the city of Perth. The campus is built on a faculty school design around a central library. Students first entered the school in 1971, and since that time a fine tradition of academic achievement and pastoral care has been



established over the years. The school is generously equipped with a hall/gymnasium, Practical and Creative Arts area (including magnificent facilities in Art, Photography, Graphics and Media), five computer areas, canteen and a separate upper school block with specialist facilities in Science, Mathematics, English and Society and Environment subject areas. The upper school area also has a Common Room facility for student recreation and relaxation.

The school has a long involvement with exchange students with established sister-school relationships with schools in Italy, China and Japan. Each year the school hosts exchange students from these schools on both short and long term exchange programs. Key features of these programs include exceptional academic, pastoral care and extra curricula support. The school also supports students who require assistance with literacy skills through the English as a Second Language Centre.

SCHOOL ETHOS

Education at Morley Senior High School is seen as a partnership between staff, parents and students. The school environment is designed to encourage students to realise their full potential in academic and vocational pursuits. Social development and participation in sporting activities are also an important part of school life. The school prides itself on providing a caring environment which caters for each person as an individual.

Each student is challenged to realise his/her full academic potential. A wide range of subjects is offered within each of the component areas.

Morley Senior High School has always achieved strong academic results in all areas of endeavour. Other features of the school's curriculum include special courses in Music, Technology, Aeronautics, Dance, Theatre Arts, Drama, Japanese, Chinese and Italian. A Gifted and Talented Program operates for more able students in Years 8, 9 and 10.

ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING

In Years 8 to 10, student learning is based upon attaining appropriate outcomes across eight learning areas. Each learning area has specific strands in which students exhibit confidence across eight levels of competence. Reports contain levels attained, outcomes achieved and teacher comments are issued each term.

In Years 11 and 12 students gain marks based on set assignment work and exam performance each semester. Certain subjects satisfy university entry; vocational subjects lead to tertiary and technical and further education (TAFE). Reports are issued each semester.
